- **National Faceless Appeals Centre (NFAC):** This centralized system streamlines e-appeal proceedings by assigning appeals to Commissioners of Income Tax (Appeal) units through an automated allocation process.

- **Electronic Verification Methods:** Taxpayers can verify their returns securely using Aadhaar OTP, net banking, or digital signatures, ensuring a quick and reliable process.
- **Seamless Department Communication:** The portal enables direct interaction with the Income Tax Department, providing access to notices, responses, and orders, eliminating the need to chase officials.
- **Pre-validated Bank Account for Refunds:** Refunds are processed electronically and credited to the taxpayer's PAN-linked bank account, ensuring timely and secure transactions.
